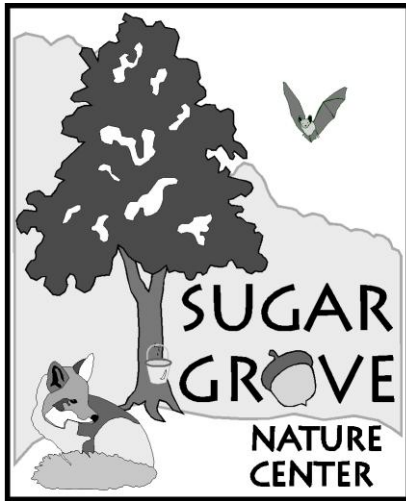

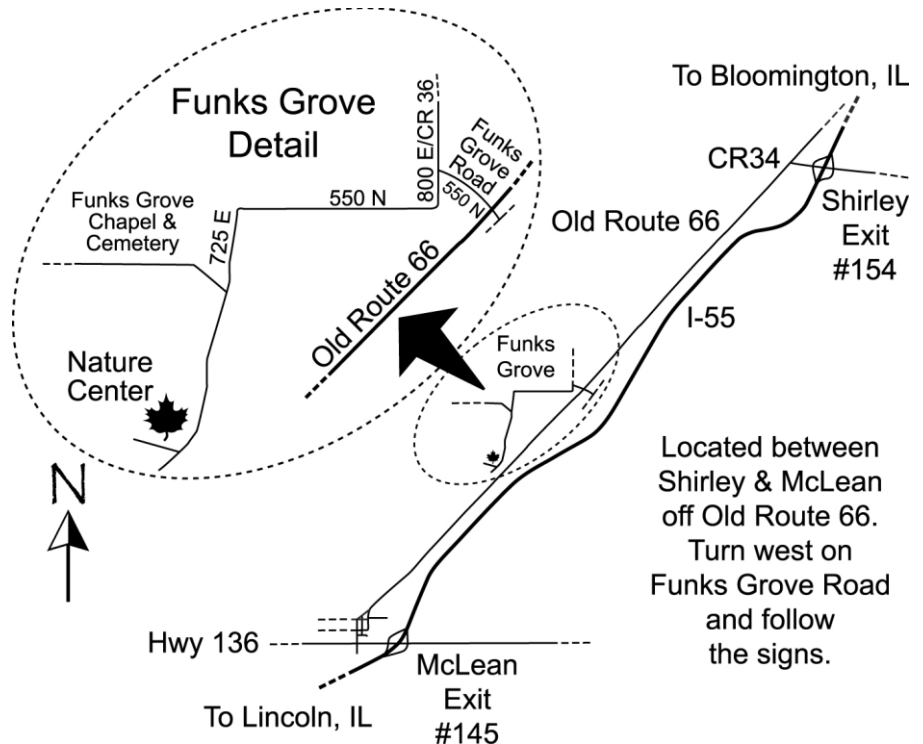

DIRECTIONS TO SUGAR GROVE NATURE CENTER

Located between Shirley & McLean off Old Route 66.
Turn west on Funks Grove Road and follow the signs.

Directions from Bloomington, IL:

Take I-55 South to the Shirley exit, #154 (first exit south of Bloomington).
Turn right at the top of the off-ramp.
Turn left (south) at the T-intersection onto Old Route 66.
Proceed approximately 4.5 miles to Funks Grove Road. Turn right.
Proceed over railroad tracks, and take the first left.
At this point, there will be signs for Sugar Grove Nature Center.
Follow this road, being careful of the two dangerous curves.
At the Dead End sign, continue straight.
Proceed past the prairie to the gravel lane.
Turn right and follow lane to the parking lot.

Directions from Lincoln, IL:

Take I-55 North to the McLean Exit.
At the end of the exit ramp turn left (west)
Take a right immediately after passing McDonalds
Turn right at the next stop sign and follow Old Route 66 North
Proceed approximately 4.5 miles to Funks Grove Road. Turn left.
Proceed over railroad tracks, and take the first left.
At this point, there will be signs for Sugar Grove Nature Center.
Follow this road, being careful of the two dangerous curves.
At the Dead End sign, continue straight.
Proceed past the prairie to the gravel lane.
Turn right and follow lane to the parking lot.
