What is Annie's Alumni?

Annie's Alumni is a gathering of Northwest Iowa women in agriculture.

Established in 2019, the group meets quarterly throughout the year and focuses on agriculture education and fellowship. Each session is designed to include supper and social time, an educational presentation and a hands-on make-and-take activity.

Attendance is open to any agri-women, with special emphasis on continuing education for those who have graduated from Annie's Project. Attendees need not have completed Annie's Project, but participation in the program is encouraged.

What is Annie's Project?

Annie's Project is an agricultural business education program that empowers farm and ranch women who want to be more knowledgeable about their ag enterprises.

Women learn best with and from other women, and Annie's Project takes advantage of that fact by creating a comfortable and supportive learning environment focused on the best farm business management practices in five key areas: financial, human resources, legal, marketing and production.
