WHEREAS, employees within these Weights and Measures programs promote equity in the marketplace by ensuring that all weighing and measuring devices used in commerce are accurate both in design and operation; and


WHEREAS, weights and measures activities have an annual estimated impact of more than \$75 billion in our state; and
