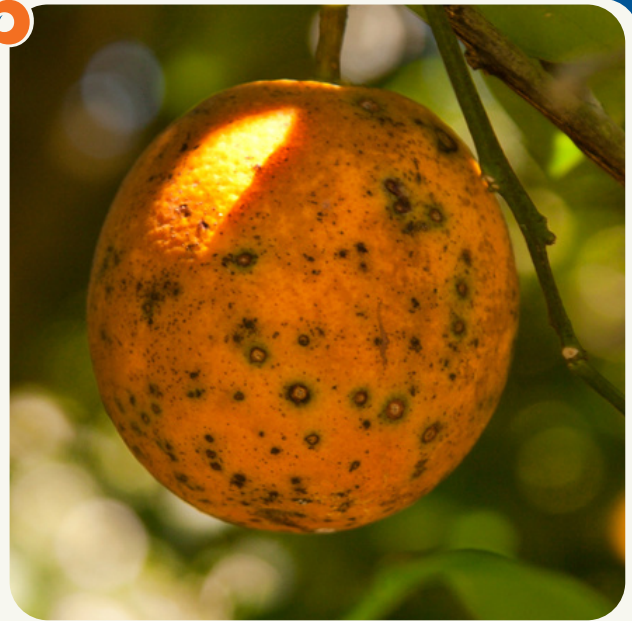


# Citrus Black Spot
